### NAVIGATING THE REPORT'S ONLINE APPENDIX

Each of the four zip files listed corresponds to one of the four CARA programs. Each folder, respectively, contains the materials that the committee received from SAMHSA about the progress of grantees of that program. The contents of each folder is described in this guide. For a more detailed description of the reporting tools and their contents and limitations, see Chapter 2 of this report.

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## **BCOR**

Source materials comprise:

- 26 WORD documents, which are the grantee progress reports received by the committee. Each is labeled with the program name (BCOR), followed by either the grantee organization name (if unredacted) or the anonymized ID given by SAMHSA.
- Four EXCEL workbooks pulled from the reports SAMHSA generated from grantee submissions to the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) tool. This data set is client-level data. In almost all cases, data is aggregated across grantees.

The first sheet within each workbook is the “workbook cover,” which describes the contents of each worksheet/tab. Within the text of the report, these are referenced by [B (for BCOR) Workbook number Worksheet number], e.g. [B1b].

## **PPW-PLT**

Source materials comprise:

- 6 WORD documents, which are the grantee progress reports received by the committee. Each is labeled with the program name (PPW-PLT), followed by either the grantee organization name (if unredacted) or the anonymized ID given by SAMHSA.
- Four EXCEL workbooks pulled from the reports SAMHSA generated from grantee submissions to the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) tool. This data set is client-level data. In almost all cases, data is aggregated across grantees.

## **OD TREATMENT ACCESS**

Source materials comprise:

- Five WORD documents [O13-17] with material submitted by five grantees in response to the Supplemental Reporting Form.
- Nine EXCEL workbooks. Within the text of the report, these are referenced by [O (for OD Treatment Access) Workbook number Worksheet number], e.g. [01b].  
O1 contains the sampled text reviewed by the committee.

There are three worksheets, the first [O1a] of which summarizes the full number of entries per DSP-MRT module by cohort. [O1b] includes the sampled entries for five of the modules within the DSP-MRT (Administration, Assessment, Capacity, Planning, and Behavioral Health Disparities) and the second includes the sampled entries for the other three modules (Implementation, Evaluation, and Sustainability). Each row of entries includes the funding cohort and the period covered by the submission (biannual for cohort 2017 and annual for cohort 2018).

- O2 contains the complete list of free-text entries for all modules under “Accomplishments.”
- O3 contains aggregated data.
- O4 contains the complete list of free-text entries for all modules under “Barriers”
- O5, 8, 12 contain the complete list of free text entries NOT included in Accomplishments or Barriers related to Behavioral Health Disparities
- O6 contains the complete list of free text entries from the Administration Module, which relates to defining high-need communities and which did not have entries for “Accomplishments” and “Barriers”.

- O10 contains the complete list of free text entries NOT included in Accomplishments or Barriers related to the Implementation module.

## **FR-CARA**

Source materials comprise 10 Excel workbooks:

- F1: one EXCEL workbook with 9 sheets. The first [F1a] contains summary information on the number of total entries per module per cohort. The remaining sheets [F1b-i] contain the sampled text entries for each of the 8 modules of the DSP-MRT. Each row of entries includes the funding cohort and the period covered by the submission (biannual for cohort 2017 and annual for cohort 2018).
- F2 contains the complete list of free text entries, from which the information in F1 was sampled, in response to the prompts for Accomplishments.
- F4 contains the complete list of free text entries, from which the information in F1 was sampled, in response to the prompts for Barriers.
- F5, F8, and F12 contain the complete list of free text entries, from which information in F1 was sampled, in response to prompts other than for Accomplishments and Barriers related to Behavioral Health Disparities.
- F6 contains the complete list of free text entries, from which information in F1 was sampled, related to the module on Administration.
- F10 contains the complete list of free text entries, from which information in F1 was sampled, in response to prompts other than for Accomplishments and Barriers related to Implementation.
- F16 contains information on naloxone kits distributed by partner organizations from the FR CARA supplemental questions in the DSP-MRT.
- F18 contains information on outcomes of naloxone kits administered by partner organizations from the FR CARA supplemental questions in the DSP-MRT.
